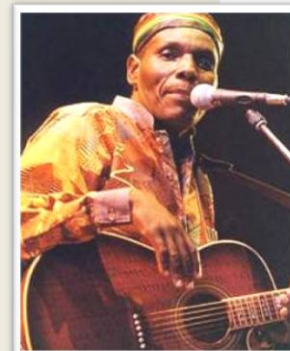
THE LAKE OF STARS FESTIVAL 2010

From the 15th to the 17th of October 2010, the shores of Lake Malawi will be a buzz with the annual Lake of Stars Festival. This year's amazing combination of musical performances, artistic demonstrations and cultural acts will be held at Nkopola Lodge. The Festival's phenomenal line-up includes the likes of highly respected local and international artists (such as the legendary Oliver Mtukudzi, Noisettes, Aly Keita and many more).

The festival will kick off against a backdrop of stunning beaches and the cichlid filled waters of Lake Malawi. Whilst the shoreline of Africa's third largest lake will provide the ideal setting for the festival, we have teamed up with the festival organizers and with well run establishments along the lakeshore to offer some practical, reasonably priced and comfortable accommodation options (all of which have easy access to the festival site).



BOOKING CONDITIONS

1. All accommodation is sold on a twin room, bed and breakfast basis (two people sharing per room).
2. All bookings must be for the duration of the festival. This means arrival on the day before and departure on the day after the festival. (i.e arrive 14th October-depart 18th October).
3. Demand for festival accommodation is huge. We will require full payment at least one month in advance to confirm accommodation. On receipt of payment we will e-mail you a non transferable voucher and also send a copy to the hotel you have booked with. The tallying of these 2 vouchers safely confirms your accommodation on arrival.
4. Payment modes will be sent to you on receipt of a confirmed booking. Please note that credit card payments do attract a 6% surcharge.

BOADZULU HOLIDAY RESORT



This comfortable resort is located only 10km from the festival site. Enjoy peace and quiet on the beach or take a cruise out to Bird Island on their floating bar. The Lodge can arrange boat excursions to Lake Malawi National Park and Mvuu Camp is located further down the Shire. Families can also visit the neighboring fish farm and crocodile farms. You can also shop for local memorabilia at Mangochi Boma market where you will find talented local vendors with a selection of unique arts, crafts and curios.
